Arbor App

It's arriving! Each primary parent or carer will shortly receive an email, inviting you to register an account with Arbor, follow the instructions in the email to register your account and download the free Arbor App from your chosen App store. Please check your junk folder carefully.



Please allow notifications when asked to do so, this will then inform you when there are new messages that need your attention.

As you may be aware your child's school has a milk scheme, administered by Cool Milk. If you'd like to opt in and have not already done so, simply register your child at www.coolmilk.com/register. Your child(ren) will continue to receive free milk whilst under the age of 5 and Cool Milk will get in touch with further information by email shortly before their 5th birthday.

For children who are already over 5, it's not too late – our scheme is flexible! As well as being able to register and make payment straight away, you can join and cancel the scheme at any time. We offer yearly, termly and half termly payment periods and a recurring payment option to give you one less thing to remember.
