HISTORY

In the autumn term, children will answer an enquiry question in each lesson which is linked to history or geography:

Does anyone really 'win' a war?

- What reasons led to the start of WW1?
- Was the Battle of the Somme a victory or a tragedy?
- Did the invention of the tank help end war more quickly- or make it more deadly?
- How did unsung heroes like Walter Tull change what it means to 'win' a war?
- Did the end of WW1 bring peace or just more problems?
- How did war change everyday life?
- Was evacuation a success?
- Did rationing bring people together or make life harder during the war?
- Did the bombing of cities bring victory- or just more suffering?
- Was the end of WW2 a victory for peace or the start of new conflicts?
- How did life change after WW2- and was it a better world for everyone?
